



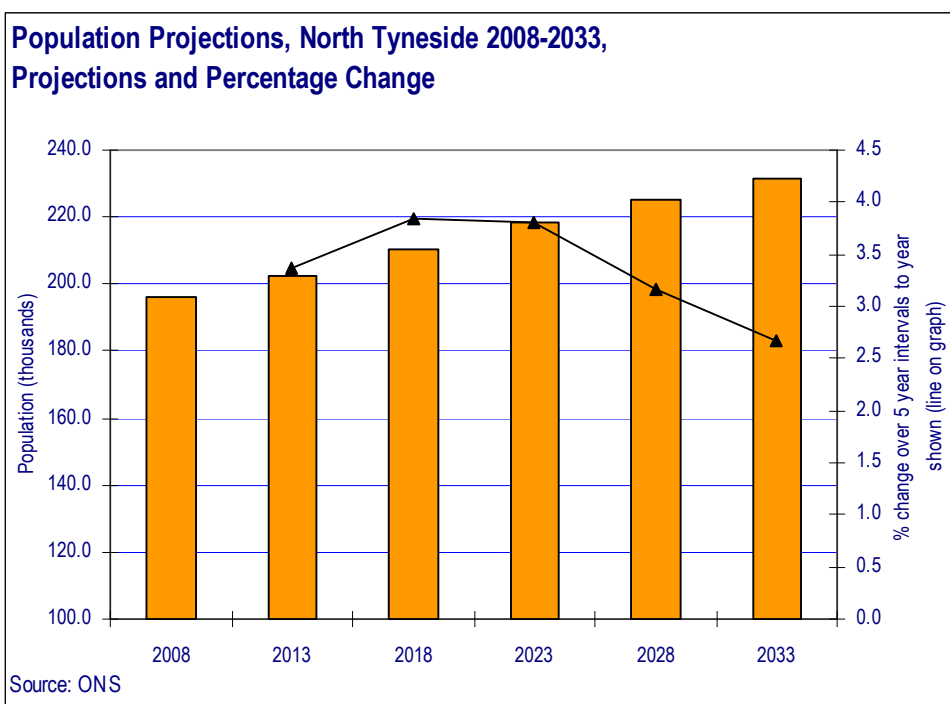
2008-Based POPULATION PROJECTIONS NORTH TYNESIDE

This bulletin provides a summary of 2008-based population projections for North Tyneside

KEY POINTS

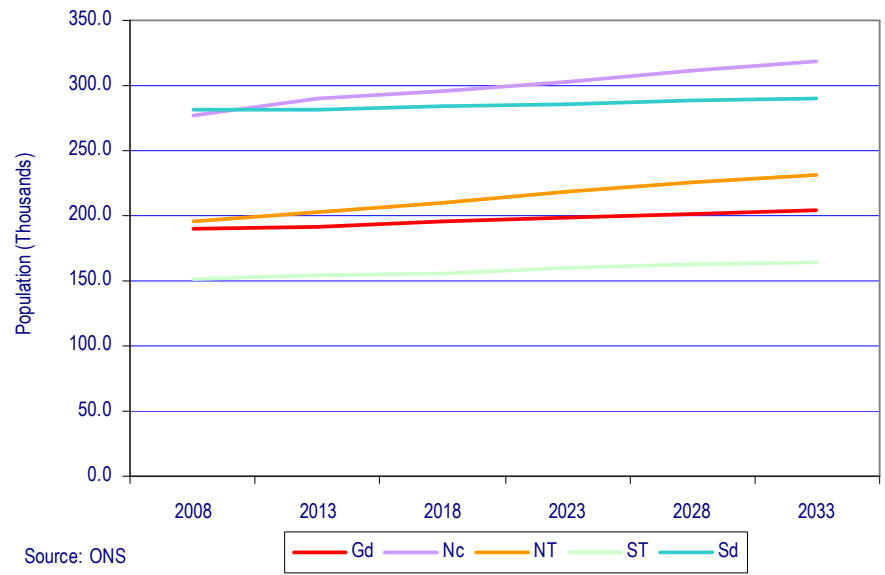
Population projections...

- The ONS projected population for North Tyneside to 2033 (based on their 2008 Mid-Year Estimates) is 231,300. This is a growth of 18.0% (or 35,300) from 2008 – the same percentage growth as for England.
- Tyne and Wear is projected to have a 10.3% (or 113,300) growth over the same period.



- Among the Districts, population growth is projected to be fastest in North Tyneside, up 18.0% (or 35,300) to 2033 - the same percentage growth as for England. Population growth is projected to be slowest in Sunderland, at 3.3% (or 9,400).
- North Tyneside's population growth is projected to peak in the 2013-2018 period, and slow particularly after 2023.
- Among the Districts, North Tyneside's population most closely resembles that of the national trend over the period 2008-2033.
